

Uniform Item	Clarifications
Boys and Girls: Khaki or Navy Blue Pants or Shorts	Uniform Style woven pants. May be boot, straight, or slim styles. Pants may have an elastic waistband, and may be navy blue or any shade of khaki. No corduroys, knit pants, jeggings, leggings, jeans or athletic shorts. <i>Shorts may be worn Sept, Oct, April, May only.</i>
Boys and Girls: Navy, Light Blue or White Polo Shirt	Short or long sleeve, pique, jersey or performance fabric. Girls may opt for ruffle style along buttons. Shirts must cover the waistband of pants and need not be tucked in if they extend no more than 2 inches below the waistband. Longer shirts must be worn tucked in with a belt.
Girls (A-E) Only: Solid Navy or Light Blue Polo Dress	Must be compatible with the style shown in photos.
Girls Only: Pleated Khaki or Navy Skort	Must be compatible with the style shown in photos.
Optional for Girls Only: Button up light pink cardigan.	Must be compatible with the style and color shown in photos. Available from www.childrensplace.com
Optional for Boys or Girls: Button up <i>or</i> Zip Up Navy Cardigan Sweater	Must be compatible with the style and color shown in photos.
Optional Boys or Girls: Solid navy, fleece zip up jacket.	Must be compatible with the style and color shown in photos. <i>Must be zip up, not pull over, and may not have a hood.</i>

Accessory Guidelines *25/26 dress code updates/additions are shown in red*

Item	Clarification
Base Layers	Base layers may be worn for extra warmth, provided they are not visible.
Socks	Solid navy, white or black socks. Knee socks may be worn with dresses and skirts.
Tights and Leggings	Navy, white or black tights or leggings may be worn under dresses or skirts.
Shoes	Closed toe, well-fitting, conservative dress or tennis shoes that secure properly to feet. Shoes must be navy, white, black, brown, grey, or light pink. <i>No lights, wheels, high heels, sandals, crocs, ostentatious colors, or cowboy boots please.</i>
Hair	Hair should be neat and tidy, and either cut short or securely styled off of the face and out of the eyes. Hair accessories include: clips, ponytail holders, hair bands in solid navy, white, black or light pink. <i>No ostentatious colors, bows, animal ears, tiaras, etc.</i>
Hats	Beanie style hats for warmth may be worn outside only. <i>No hats in the classroom.</i>
Jewelry and Makeup	Small earrings and non-ostentatious jewelry are allowed. Logic level girls may wear light makeup.
Undershorts	Girls must wear bike shorts under dresses and skirts that do not already have built-in shorts.
Rain or Snow Boots	Rain or snow boots may be worn <i>to</i> the classroom, but not <i>in</i> the classroom. <i>Students will need to bring their regular shoes and swap.</i>
Coats and Jackets	Students may wear any coat or jacket to school and outside on break, but they may not be worn inside the classroom. Please provide a sweater, cardigan, or navy fleece zip-up for use in the classroom as shown in the pictures.
*All clothing and accessories should be clean, properly fitting, and without major stains or holes.
