Uniform Item	Clarifications
Navy or Khaki Dress Slacks Navy or Khaki Dress Shorts <i>Sept, Oct, Apr. May only</i>	Available from landsend.com or other retailers with similar styles Uniform Style woven pants (or shorts in appropriate months) May be boot, straight, or slim styles. No jeans, joggers, cargo style, or sweatpants.
Navy, light blue, or white polo shirt, short or long sleeve	Available from landsend.com or other retailers with similar styles Shirts must be long enough to be tucked in.
White, black, or navy socks	Must be solid color (black allowed only when wearing pants)
Brown, black, white, or navy shoes	Must be closed toed, secure on foot, appropriate for walking. Dress or tennis shoes permitted when sole and laces are white or match the color of the shoe (see examples) No high heels, Crocs, cowboy boots, light-up shoes, wheeled shoes, or other attention-drawing styles.
Optional: Belt	Brown, black or navy leather or faux leather.
Optional: Navy sweater, sweater vest, cardigan, or zip up sweater (not sweatshirt)	Available from landsend.com or other retailers with similar styles Multiple styles permitted (please see Land's End school store)
Optional: Solid navy, 1/4 zip or full zip up fleece with or without a Mountain Scholars or WHA logo	<i>May not have a hood</i> Available from landsend.com and other retailers with similar styles <i>May also choose a Mountain Scholars logo fleece avail. From landsend.com</i> Please purchase a sweater or fleece zip up if your child needs extra layers. <i>Jackets and sweatshirts are not permitted in the classroom.</i>

Accessory Guidelines: All A-PL Students

Girls Hair	<p>Hair must be combed. It should be neat and tidy, and styled off of the face and out of the eyes in a manner that is not distracting to oneself or others.</p> <p>Hair accessories may include: clips, ponytail holders, hair bands, and bows in solid navy, white, black, brown, or pink.</p> <p>No ostentatious colors, animal ears, tiaras, etc.</p> <p>No un-natural hair dyes or styles (blue hair, pink extensions, etc.)</p>
Boys Hair	<p>Must be cut neatly and conservatively so as not to hang in the eyes and be a distraction to oneself and others.</p> <p>No ostentatious styles such as pony tails, man buns, mullets, mohawks, etc.</p> <p>No un-natural hair dyes or styles (blue hair, pink extensions, etc.)</p>
Hats	<p>Beanie style hats for warmth may be worn outside only</p> <p><i>Baseball caps and other hats may not be brought to school or worn on school grounds</i></p>
Jewelry and Makeup	<p>Girls may wear conservative jewelry and PreLogic girls may wear light makeup.</p> <p>Boys may wear a conservative necklace and ring (no earrings).</p>
Undershorts Recommended	<p>It is highly recommended that girls wear bike shorts under dresses and skirts that do not already have built-in shorts.</p>
Rain or Snow Boots	<p>Rain or snow boots may be worn <i>to</i> the classroom, but not <i>in</i> the classroom.</p> <p><i>Students will need to bring their regular shoes and swap before class.</i></p>
Outerwear: Coats and Jackets	<p>Students may wear a zip up outerwear coat or jacket with a hood to school and outside on breaks.</p> <p><i>No sweatshirts including pullover hoodies or zip up hoodies are allowed on campus and may not be worn as a coat/jacket to school.</i></p>
<p>*All clothing and accessories should be clean, properly fitting, and without major stains or holes.</p>
