

Dress Code Options for Seniors Mon-Wed

As our seniors approach adulthood, they have an opportunity to practice dressing professionally. Instead of the Logic and Rhetoric Uniform, they have a dress code they may follow. They have two clothing options while on campus Mon-Wed:

- **Option 1:** Wear the normal Rhetoric Monday-Wednesday Dress Code.
- **Option 2:** Match the dress code of our teachers

Teacher Dress Code:

We expect teachers to dress as nicely and professionally as possible, while remaining comfortably able to perform their classroom duties. Teachers should keep in mind the dress code required of their students and lead by example, appropriately *matching or exceeding* those requirements.

Appropriate for Men:

- Slacks—dress or chino style
- Collared shirts: oxford or polo
- Sweaters, sweater vests, or cardigans in solid colors
- Neck ties and jackets
- Casual or dress shoes: boots, oxfords, etc.

Appropriate for Women

- Slacks—dress or chino style
- Collared shirts: oxford or polo
- Sweaters, blouses, women’s cut tee (no logo or graphic shirts)
- Skirts, dresses
- Leggings under a dress or skirt
- Sweaters, sweater vests, or cardigans in solid colors
- Jackets
- Casual or dress shoes: flats, boots, clogs, oxfords, etc.

Inappropriate for Everyone:

- Jeans including those in colors other than blue
- Workout clothing: leggings, joggers, athletic shorts (Exception: recreation and PE Staff)
- Sweatshirts of any style including hoodies, zip up hoodies, and pull overs
- Logo or graphic shirts (small brand name on lapel is fine)
- Sneakers or athletic shoes (Exception: recreation and PE Staff)
- Clothing, accessories or hair that are overly trendy or attention-grabbing, including ripped or distressed styles, ostentatious colors, etc.

Jeans or Slacks/chino pants (<i>women and men</i>) Skirts (<i>women</i>) Shorts (<i>Apr, May, Sept, Oct only</i>)	<p>Neat, clean pants in good repair. No holes or tears. No joggers, athletic, cargo, or sweatpants or cargo or athletic shorts</p> <p>Skirt and shorts length must extend to at least the student’s fingertips when standing upright with arms relaxed at their sides.</p>
Casual Shoes	<p>Closed toes required. Shoes must be appropriately non-distracting. Cowboy boots in good repair may be worn on casual Thursdays The following are not permitted: very high heels, Crocs, light-up shoes, wheeled shoes, or similarly attention-drawing styles.</p>

About Casual Thursday: Casual Thursday wear is limited to the above items only. Dressing down on Thursdays is a joyful privilege, but not a requirement. *Students may choose to wear the normal M-W uniform.* Students who consistently violate the Code of Conduct and/or the Casual Thursday dress code will be required to wear the Monday-Wednesday uniform instead.
