Uniform Item	Clarifications
Navy Blue Dress Slacks  Navy Blue Dress Shorts <i>(Apr, May, Sept, Oct only)</i>	Available from <a href="https://landsend.com">landsend.com</a> or other retailers with similar styles Uniform Style woven pants (or shorts in appropriate months) May be boot, straight, or slim styles. No jeans, joggers, cargo style, or sweatpants. <b><i>Khaki pants/shorts are no longer a part of our Logic Level Uniform</i></b>
White polo shirt, short or long sleeve	Available from <a href="https://landsend.com">landsend.com</a> or other retailers with similar styles Shirts must be long enough to be tucked in. <b><i>Light blue and navy polo shirts are no longer a part of our Logic Level Uniform</i></b>
Belt	Brown, black or navy leather or faux leather.
White, black, or navy socks	Must be solid color (black allowed only when wearing pants)
Brown, black, white, or navy shoes	Must be closed toed, secure on foot, appropriate for walking. Dress shoes are suggested. Basic tennis shoes are permitted with laces and soles in white or in the same color as the shoe
<b>Optional:</b> White button down dress/oxford shirt, short or long sleeve	Available from <a href="https://landsend.com">landsend.com</a> or other retailers with similar styles Must be tucked in and worn with the uniform neck tie. <b><i>Recommended for students who prefer a more formal (Rhetoric-style) uniform.</i></b>
<b>Optional:</b> Neck Tie only in “Classic Navy Large Plaid”	<b>Must</b> be purchased from <a href="https://landsend.com">landsend.com</a> . May only be worn with a button down dress/oxford shirt. Recommended for students who prefer a more formal (Rhetoric-style) uniform.
<b>Optional:</b> Red sweater/sweater vest	<b>Must</b> be purchased from <a href="https://landsend.com">landsend.com</a> .
<b>Optional:</b> Navy cardigan or zip up sweater (not sweatshirt)	Available from <a href="https://landsend.com">landsend.com</a> or other retailers with similar styles
<b>Optional:</b> Solid navy, half zip or full zip up fleece with or without a Mountain Scholars or WHA logo	Available from <a href="https://landsend.com">landsend.com</a> , or <a href="https://shorturl.at/ru12N">https://shorturl.at/ru12N</a> (MS) or <a href="https://shorturl.at/HUS4M">https://shorturl.at/HUS4M</a> (WHA) Please purchase a sweater, cardigan, and/or fleece zip up if your child needs extra layers. <i>May not have a hood</i> <b><i>Jackets, sweatshirts, and non-uniform sweaters are not permitted in the classroom.</i></b>

## Accessory Guidelines: All Logic and Rhetoric Students

<b>Girls Hair</b>	<p>Hair must be combed. It should be neat and tidy, and styled off of the face and out of the eyes in a manner that is not distracting to oneself or others.</p> <p>Hair accessories may include: clips, ponytail holders, hair bands, and bows in solid navy, white, black, brown, or red.</p> <p>No ostentatious colors, animal ears, tiaras, etc.</p> <p>No un-natural hair dyes (blue hair, pink extensions, etc.)</p>
<b>Boys Hair</b>	<p>Must be cut neatly and conservatively so as not to hang in the eyes and be a distraction to oneself and others. No ostentatious styles such as pony tails, man buns, mullets, mohawks, etc.</p> <p>No un-natural hair dyes (blue hair, pink extensions, etc.)</p>
<b>Hats</b>	<p>Beanie style hats for warmth may be worn outside only</p> <p><b><i>Baseball caps and other hats may not be brought to school or worn on campus</i></b></p>
<b>Jewelry and Makeup</b>	<p>Girls may wear conservative jewelry and light makeup.</p> <p>Boys may wear a conservative necklace and ring (no earrings).</p>
<b>Undershorts Recommended</b>	<p>It is recommended that girls wear bike shorts under dresses and skirts that do not already have built-in shorts.</p>
<b>Rain or Snow Boots</b>	<p>Rain or snow boots may be worn <i>to</i> the classroom, but not <i>in</i> the classroom.</p> <p><i>Students will need to bring their regular shoes and swap before class.</i></p>
<b>Coats and Jackets</b>	<p>Students may wear a zip up coat or jacket to school and outside on breaks.</p> <p><b><i>No sweatshirts including pullover hoodies or zip up hoodies are allowed on campus and may not be worn as a coat/jacket to school except for approved styles on Casual Thursdays for Rhetoric students only (see Casual Thursday Dress Code)</i></b></p>
<p>*All clothing and accessories should be clean, properly fitting, and without major stains or holes.</p>
